Dreidel Directions

Making the Dreidel:

1. Color the dreidel and cut along the outside edge.
2. Fold the four squares into a cube/box.
3. Punch a hole in the top square and fold it down.
4. Fold each shaded flap. Add glue to the front of each flap and hold in place against the inside of box for several seconds.
5. Place a pencil or straw in hole on top. Dreidel should spin on table like a top.

Playing Dreidel:

1. Each player begins with 10-15 pieces of chocolate coins (Hanukkah gelt) or other objects...raisins, pennies, nuts...
2. Each player places one coin (game piece) into the "kitty" or center "pot". Then, each person takes a turn spinning the dreidel.
 - If the dreidel lands with the "Nun" facing up, the player wins nothing.
 - If the dreidel lands with the "Gimmel" facing up, the player takes all the prizes in the middle.
 - If the dreidel lands with the "Hey" facing up, the player takes half the kitty. (Odd number=player takes $\frac{1}{2}$ plus one.)
 - If the dreidel lands with the "Shin" facing up, the player must place two prizes in the kitty.
3. Each player must put one game piece in the pot before the next person spins, when the pot is empty, or when only one game piece is left in the kitty.

When players do not have any game pieces left, they are out. The person who collects all the game pieces is the winner.
